

CONDITIONS OF RENTAL

BOOKINGS:

A tentative booking may be made but must be confirmed in writing within 14 days. Confirmation must be accompanied by a booking fee of 15%. THIS FEE IS NOT REFUNDABLE ON CANCELLATION OF BOOKING. Bookings not confirmed within 14 days will make The Salvation Army free to negotiate with other groups.

FINAL NUMBERS AND CANCELATION POLICY:

1. If a group's actual numbers (on arrival) are less than the final number booked (7 days before), the renter agrees to pay the final numbers fee.

WEEKEND BOOKINGS:

A two day weekend is deemed to commence after dinner being 7:00pm on the Friday to 2:00pm on the Sunday. If groups wish to arrive earlier /or leave later this can be arranged on request at a small additional charge.

GUIDELINE /,CONDITIONS

1. *ALCOHOL /DRUGS* -- Under no circumstances is any alcohol or any non-prescription drugs to be brought on to the property.
2. *SMOKING* -- is not permitted in any of the buildings.
3. *FIRES* -- No fires may be lit without the permission of the camp management.
4. *CLEANING*--The facility is expected to be kept in a clean and tidy state. At the close of occupancy, each group is to leave the property in the way in which it was found. This includes rooms and grounds. All furniture must be returned to its original position.
5. *PROPERTY DAMAGE AND LOSS* ,..All breakages and losses to the camps property or equipment will be reported .These will be invoiced to the group. The camp takes no responsibility for the loss or damage to personal property. Guests are only permitted to access the buildings they have been allotted.
6. *ILLNESS* -- In the event of illness, accident or misfortune, the rental group recognizes that The Salvation Army, its staff or volunteers are not liable or obligated to pay for any dentist, doctor or hospital services, x-rays, drugs or other related services.
7. *SUPERVISION* --- The guest group will be responsible to satisfy itself that the participants of any activity have the necessary skill, provide any necessary supervision by reasonable persons and see that all individual safety requirements are observed by participants. The Salvation Army Beaver Creek Camp reserves the right to insist upon all appropriate safety rules and procedures being observed as well as to limit or terminate the use of any such special facility as it may consider advisable.
